

Nondiscrimination Policy

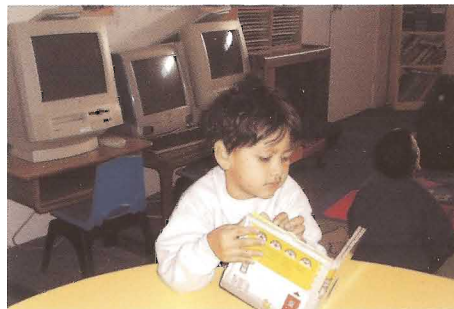

Admission Policy

Children entering Kindergarten in September must be 5 years old by November 1st. Before final acceptance, parents must submit completed registration forms, birth certificate, updated immunization records, and the registration fee. Our kindergarten is a full day program that coincides with the hours of the rest of the school.

Parents of transfer students must bring a copy of the student's most recent report card, health records and sacramental information. There is a nonrefundable registration fee due at the time of registration.

Student Life

In addition to a strong academic program, St. Joseph offers a strong religious program. Daily religion classes are a regular part of the curriculum. Students have regular opportunities to participate in masses and prayer services. Students in grades 6, 7 and 8 must complete a service hours requirement as part of their religion classes.

Students at St. Joseph have a variety of choices of involvement in the school community outside the classroom. Students may join student council, sports teams for both boys and girls, altar servers, yearbook, and cheerleaders. The school also has boy scout and girl scout troops associated with the school.

All students wear school uniforms that can be purchased from two different local companies. On free dress days, there is still a dress code that is strictly enforced.

The school's computer lab offers access to the Internet and is a valuable learning and research tool.

Tuition and Fees

St. Joseph has special tuition rates for families. Tuition is paid through FACTS in twelve monthly payments. In addition to tuition and an annual book and supply fee, parents are asked to perform service hours each year, as well as purchase scrip. There are also fundraisers held throughout the year that help in keeping tuition rates at an affordable level.

Extended Day Care

For an additional fee, St. Joseph does offer extended day care for students in all grades until 6:00 p.m. throughout the school year.
